Hike Location: 5526 E Dublin Granville Rd, New Albany, OH 43054 ([map](#))

Directions:

From South: I-270 N to SR-161 E towards New Albany. Take Exit 43 to N Hamilton Road, turn right onto N Hamilton Road. Turn left onto E Dublin Granville Road. In the roundabout take second exit. Park is .4 miles on the left.

From West: I-270 E to exit 30 onto SR-161 towards New Albany. Keep left to merge onto SR-161 E towards New Albany. Take Exit 43 to N Hamilton Road, turn right onto N Hamilton Road. Turn left onto E Dublin Granville Road. In the roundabout take second exit. Park is .4 miles on the left.

Hike Description:

Walking flat paved trail loops with wood boardwalks. Tennis shoes can be worn, weather permitting. Bathrooms at the parking lot.

Taylor Farm Park in New Albany, Ohio, was originally a family farm, with the main farmhouse (still on the property) built around 1842 by Anthony Wayne Taylor. The Taylor family owned the 650-acre property for generations until it was sold to The New Albany Company in 2020 as part of a wetland mitigation project. The city of New Albany acquired the land in 2021 and opened the first phase of the park in 2023, preserving the historical aspects while creating new recreational areas.
